## Park Theatre Act & Play Creative Learning Classes Safety

At Park Theatre we will do our best to keep the Act & Play class safe, but we need your help to achieve a safe and secure environment.

At Park Theatre we need your help to keep you and others safe.

At Park Theatre we expect you to abide by the following commitments:

**You will not bully, intimidate or harass any user.**

**You will not upload viruses or other malicious code.**

**You will not solicit login information or access an account belonging to someone else.**

**You will not post content that: is hate speech, threatening or pornographic; incites violence; or contains nudity or graphic or gratuitous violence.**

**You will not post unauthorised commercial communications (such as spam).**

**You will not engage in unlawful multi-level marketing, such as a pyramid scheme.**

## Registration

At Park Theatre we ask that children under 11 years old are with an adult during the class. We will encourage parents and guardians to also have access to the group and they will be aware that the group exists. The code of conduct also applies to the adults that are with you during class.

At Park Theatre we ask that you set your display name to be your first name, of the person who has booked the class for you and initial of your last name (e.g. John S).

At Park Theatre we will disable your accounts should you be inactive over a period of time, or if you leave the programme.

At Park Theatre we will disable your account if you have broken The Park Theatre code of conduct.

You can deactivate your account at any time.

You must not share your password.

You must not let anyone else access your account.

### **Protecting other people's rights.**

At Park Theatre we respect other people's rights and expect you to do the same.

You will not post content or behave unkind to other Park Theatre members, which infringes upon or violates someone else's rights or violates the law of expected behaviour.
